

Comte Senard

"LES CHAMPS LONGS" AOC, Chorey-Lès-Beaune

Domaine Comte Senard had an auspicious start in 1857 when Jules Senard, the great grandfather of current owner Philippe Senard, created the Corton- Clos des Meix monopole. Since that time, the Domaine has continued its acquisition of property in prestigious appellations, with current holdings of 22 acres of land. Passed down for 5 generations, since 2005 it has been under the management of Lorraine Senard. The Domaine produces wines that are seductive representations of the power of Corton, built to age with finesse and grace.

100% Pinot Noir

SOIL TYPE

Alluvial soils mixed with limestone and gravels for drainage

VINEYARD

25 y/o vines 0.62 acre Located between Aloxe-Corton & Ladoix-Serrigny Plot: Les Champs Longs

HARVEST

Manual harvesting & sorted

VINIFICATION

Whole-cluster Ambient yeast 14 months of aging in barrels (40% new oak) No fining, no filtration

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of raspberry, Morello cherry and blackberry set off by notes of liquorice, underbrush and leather. Well-rounded structure leaves an aftertaste of fruit and elegant tannins on the palate.
