

Comte Senard

"CLOS DES MEIX" MONOPOLE AOC, Corton Grand Cru

Domaine Comte Senard had an auspicious start in 1857 when Jules Senard, the great grandfather of current owner Philippe Senard, created the Corton- Clos des Meix monopole. Since that time, the Domaine has continued its acquisition of property in prestigious appellations, with current holdings of 22 acres of land. Passed down for 5 generations, since 2005 it has been under the management of Lorraine Senard. The Domaine produces wines that are seductive representations of the power of Corton, built to age with finesse and grace.



COUNTRY

France

VARIETAL

100% Pinot Noir

SOIL TYPE

Brown limestone and rich deposits of white marl with high potassium

VINEYARD

35 y/o vines 3 acres 650 ft elevation Facing south-east.

HARVEST

Manual harvesting & sorted 4,000 bottles production.

VINIFICATION

50% de-stemmed 18 months aging in 350L barrels (50% new oak) 330 cases production

TASTING NOTES

Complex aromas of wild berries, cherries, violets with spicy and earthy hints. Rich mouthfeel with delicate expression of dark berry fruits. The texture is pure and elegant, with very fine tannins and a beautiful structure.
