

Domaine Georges Glantenay

A.O.C Volnay 1er Cru Les Brouillards

Coming from a line of winegrowers from father to son since the 17th century, this domaine located in Volnay in Côte-d'Or, Burgundy, is a family winery born from the sharing of the estate of Pierre Glantenay in 1893. After his son Georges then his grandson Pierre, it is now the fourth generation who is at the head of the estate, represented by Guillaume and Sarah, brother and sister.

This domaine has 8 hectares of vines, managed in organic practices agriculture, with the greatest respect for the terroir. They strive every day to maintain and embellish the family heritage, but also to expand it as soon as an opportunity arises.

100% destemmed Native yeasts Stainless steel vats Aging15 months French Oak 40% New Barrels 3 more months aging in vats

TASTING NOTES

Shimmering ruby color, the nose exhales powerful aromas of red and black fruits, accompanied by notes of spices. On the palate, the fruit is bright, energetic with a complex and rich texture, and a beautiful minerality. The structured tannins bring the right balance to this distinguished wine.
