

Domaine Vincent & Jean-Pierre Charton

A.O.C. Mercurey 1er Cru La Chassiere

The Charton family has owned this 21 acre Domaine since 1940 and is recognized as one of the most reputable Mercurey Producers. Vincents, third generation was nominated in the top 10 of best young Winemakers of Burgundy in 2010. At an elevation of 700 feet, the Domaine's 30 years old vines grow on a south facing hillside between 230 and 320 meters elevation. They extend over marl, limestone and calcareous clay soil that store the warmth of the day.
