CHARDONNAY I.G.P. Vin de Pays D'Oc

Stéphane Bouix family has been in the wine industry for 5 generations. They own and harvest their own vineyards in the villages of Nages and Solorgues in South of France, not far from Nîmes. The "Haut de Mourier" name comes from vineyards plots situated in the "Les Mouriers" tiny locality on the hillsides of the two villages. There are 1 ha Cinsault, 3 ha Cabernet Sauvignon, 3 ha Pinot Noir, 5 ha Chardonnay and 12 ha Viognier. This unique vineyards around the Roman City of Nimes allows diversity by its situation and its weather conditions.



COUNTRY

VARIETAL

100% Chardonnay

SOIL TYPE

Old terrace covered with clay-limestone colluvium.

VINEYARD

15 years old vines South of France-10 km from Nimes Elevation: 50 - 80 meters

HARVEST

Harvest at maturity

VINIFICATION

Direct pressing of the grapes 10 to 12 weeks aging Fine lees

TASTING NOTES

This wine from grapes harvested at optimum maturity has a bright green color with a hint of lemon yellow. The aromas are complex blending notes buttered lime, hawthorn. Although ample and suave this wine retains a beautiful freshness that comes back in the mouth bring back the first aromatic sensations olfactory. This wine will seduce you with its assertive personality. As an accompaniment: shellfish and crustaceans.
