Domaine de l'Abbaye, surrounded by terraces was once connected to the Abbey of Thoronet. At that time, the monks were cultivating the land that now belongs to Frank Petit. In 1990 this Cuvée was the first to be rated 3 stars by the Guide Hachette in France.

The selection of this UV protectant blue bottle highlights Franc Petit's uncompromising dedication to high quality rosé. Rosé wines, bottled in February usualy get tired after a few months, but when we tasted a 2 year old vintag in November, we were amazed by the quality and freshness of this wine due to the protective UV screen of the blue bottle.
