Château Saint Pierre dates back to the eleventh century. Recent rehabilitation work in the cellar have revealed vestiges of a church dedicated to Saint Pierre that had belonged to Foulques, Lord Of Les Arcs. This property and the land around it were bequeathed to the Saint Victor Abbey in 1055.

Handed down from father to son for the past four generations, Jean-Philippe Victor now manage this 55 hectares vineyards that stretch from the Argens River up to the foot of the Maures Mountains.

SOIL TYPE

Clay, Limestone Gravel, Flint

VINEYARD

West to East Benefits of Very Warm Summers & the Mistral (Dry Strong WInd) keeps the vineyard dry and disease free.

HARVEST

Manual harvested & sorted

VINIFICATION

Maceration for 4-12 hours. Pressing is gentle. Natural decanting of the juice

TASTING NOTES

Elegant pink-salmon color with a powerful nose of white peaches, candied apricots, guava, exotic fruit blossoms and a hint of spices. Great fullness in the mouth, a rich wine with great character and excellent aromatic length.
