VARIETAL 70% Grenache 30% Syrah

SOIL TYPE Clay and Sand

VINEYARD Villages near Cavillargues

HARVEST Starts always at night

VINIFICATION Traditional cement tank fermentation.

TASTING NOTES

Subtle notes of plums, black cherries, violets with hints of black olives, licorice and spices. Very pleasant and silky texture with well integrated tannins. Great balance!
