SANKT LAURENT D.A.C. Thermenregion

Schneider Winery has put its focus on the red grape varieties of the burgundy family Pinot Noir and the autochthonous Sankt Laurent. This specialization is attributed to the excellent growing conditions that mirror a close working dialogue with the continental climate, the volcanic gravelly soils and the skills and passion of the individual vintners.

The Thermenregion vineyards nestle on the slopes of the Vienna Woods and its foothills and face south to southeast. Vines benefit from a Pannonian subcontinental climate with hot and dry summers, dry weather in autumn and a relatively cool winter.



COUNTRY

VARIETAL

100% Sankt Laurent

Cultivated by the Cistercian Monks around the year 1240. Named after Saint Lawerence's Day, August 10th when the grapes begin to change color.

SOIL TYPES

Chernozem (Black Soil) Limestone & Gravel

VINEYARD

Near the town of Tattendorf Vineyards Frauenfeld & Seia

HARVEST

Hand harvesting

VINIFICATION

Fermentation in stainless steel tanks Aged 12 months 1500-2500 liter oak barrels

TASTING NOTES

Dark ruby with violet highlights. Cherry and blackberry in the nose. Juicy, refreshing acid and tightly woven tannins build a pleasant frame for red berry fruit. Long mineral finish.
