

Château La Croix Bellevue

A.O.C. Lalande de Pomerol

Tightly bound to his terroir, his merlot vine stocks and determined to produce great wines, the Trocard family has been running for 14 generations (1628) a high-quality vineyard in the heart of Libournais encompassing Saint Emilion and Pomerol.

Restricted to a few hectares in the XVII century, the Trocard family owned vineyards expanded with Jean Trocard, who demonstrated his talent of winemaker in 1945. His son Jean-Louis Trocard took over the estate with his wife Elizabeth Trocard-Decons in 1976. Since then, the Trocard Vineyards have acquired an international stature with extension of the vineyard area from 20 to 90 hectares.



COUNTRY

France

VARIETAL

50% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon

SOIL TYPE

Gravelly slopes.

VINEYARD

Southern Exposure facing Pomerol. Debudding, thinning out of leaves and green harvest are carried out in the vineyard.

HARVEST

The harvest is performed manually to ensure optimum maturity and perfect sorting out the berries.

VINIFICATION

Aged 14 months 50% new oak barriques

TASTING NOTES

Good red color. Pleasant and generous nose. Between blackcurrant, red fresh fruit and menthol. Fine and voluble aromas. Large smoothness. Complex. The attack is very coated. It is structured and filled by a molted. Beautiful behaviour in mouth, beautiful structure. Very beautiful length.
