

Château Morin

Saint-Estèphe AOC, France

Located in Saint Corbian, one of the highest place in Saint Estephe, this chateau is calm, peaceful, and in the sharpness of its 18th century style. The Chateau was born in the early eighteenth century. the Morin then family CAMIRAN exploit it. In 1858, Dr. Constant ALIBERT acquired the estate. In 1890 his son Paul, a well known banker in Pauil- lac, leads the property. In 1947 Mrs. Sidaine, his daughter inherits the family estate, and afterwards her children and Marguerite Maxime Sidaine. They exploit the property since the death of their mother in 1972. In July 2005, the estate was bought by Chateau de PEZ, owned by Roederer champagnes.

VINIFICATION

Traditional Vinification 18 months ageing Barrels and vats.

TASTING NOTES

Deep garnet with ruby tints Refined nose of ripe red and black fruits with cacao note, roasted coffee touch and elegant oak. Deli- cate attack, leading into a smooth, ample; round palate with silky tannins and expressive aromas. Refined across the palate.
