

Château Tenein A.O.C. Bordeaux Supérieur

For many generations, the Grelaud family has owned and exploited the vineyard of Chateau Tenein. Tenein is a small estate located on the southern hills of the Isle Valley 12 miles east of Saint-Emilion in the village of Gours, within the Bordeaux Superieur appellation. The vineyards are planted on siliceous clay hills with a density over 5,000 vines per hectare. Total size of the vineyard is about 15ha or 37 acres.

Traditional fermentation on skins Small stainless steel vats, 12 to 15 months aging French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

A wine rich that has complex aromas with hints of spice typical of the cabernet sauvignon grape. On the palate, Chateau Tenein is pleasantly smooth with smoky and toasted noted.
