

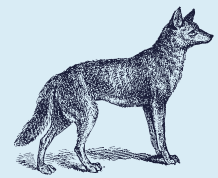


Little Boat

Full Burgundy style
Completely de-stemmed,
5 days of cold soak at 50F,
Gentle extraction with irrigation
Pressed at dryness on the skins
20 months aging 35% new oak
barrel 100% French oak
Final blend unique barrel selection

TASTING NOTES

Elegant, complex, well balanced and easy to drink. Amazing concentration of wild cherry, strawberry and mineral notes, with a silky texture and great harmony supported by refined tannins that lead to a long smooth finish.
