VINIFICATION

Barrel selection Tons per Acre: 1.86 12 months aging on lie 35% new, 30% once-filled, 25% twice-filled and 10% neutral French oak 932 cases

TASTING NOTES

This barrel selection brings bright flavors of salmonberry and raspberry, with highlights of citrus peel. It's precise and tart; less ripe than many wines from this warm year, but balanced and focused.
