

Domaine Philippe Bouzereau A.O.C Meursault 1er Cru Poruzots

It is at the foot of the vineyards of the old Chateau Clos de Citeaux that takes place this Domaine, in the heart of the village of Meursault. The work of the vine is a family tradition since 9 generations. In 2006, Philippe Bouzereau Jr. took over the Domaine to perpetuate the savoir-faire in the development of Grand Vins de Bourgogne. From Aloxe-Corton in the north, to Santenay in the south, through Beaune, Auxey-Duresses, Meursault and Puligny-Montrachet, a multitude of small parcelles make up the mosaic of these wines. This allows to offer to the tasting a great diversity of soils.

VARIETAL 100% Chardonnay

SOIL TYPE Shallow clay soil, frequent rock outcrop.

VINEYARD

10 ha. 50 to 70 years old vines Planted in massal selection Located between Gouttes d'Or and Genevrières.

HARVEST

Manual harvesting & sorted, twice

VINIFICATION

Fermentation fine lees 12 months aging in barrels 30% new oak 6 more months aging Stainless still vats

TASTING NOTES

Wonderful bouquet of hawthorn blossoms, green apple, hazelnut, amber, lemon-grass with flinty minerals. This wine combines grace with a well defined character and a remarkable concentration and freshness. Long and persistent finish with floral, fruit and mineral notes.
