

Liquid Farm RADIAN VINEYARD PINOT NOIR A.V.A. Santa Rita Hills

Started in 2009 with only 4 barrels of Chardonnay, all from the same vineyard in the Sta. Rita Hills. The original idea was to make one wine. However, the wine itself had a different plan and we gladly listened. Since then, we've had the opportunity to expand our lineup by accessing chardonnay grapes from other vineyards in the Sta. Rita Hills and the neighboring sister AVA of Santa Maria, and produce wines like La Hermana and our flagship, Four.



COUNTRY USA

VARIETAL 100% Pinot Noir

SOIL TYPE Diatomaceous, sandy loam, Clay and shale

VINEYARD Westernmost along Santa Rosa Rd Sta. Rita Hills East and West rows

HARVEST Manually harvested

VINIFICATION

Native Yeast 15% Whole Cluster 15% New Oak. Fermented in Stainless steel open top fermenters. 16 Months aging in Barrel on the lees

TASTING NOTES

Ruby to light red in color. Floral notes of rose petal, dried herbs and both black and red cherry. Medium-bodied with firm and fine tannins. The finish persists with complexity and earthiness of the vineyard shines through. This wine drinks well now, and yet has so much tension it can age for years.
