

# **Dragonette** PINOT NOIR "BLACK LABEL" A.V.A. Santa Rita Hills

Located at the cool, foggy windswept western edge of northern Santa Barbara County, Sta. Rita Hills is justly renowned for producing world class Pinot Noir. Strive to create Pinot Noirs of textural purity, complexity and balance. Complexity and balance are achieved by meticulous attention to detail in the vineyard, where each vineyard block is managed for appropriate canopy and proper yields. Textural purity can only result where the delicate and ethereal Pinot Noir is very gently handed without manipulation. Thus, it's age the wines on their lees, without racking, with little movement and constant topping. Each wine is bottled only after sufficient time in barrel to permit ideal evolution.

This reserve level wine is a blend of our favorite barrels, each selected for its outstanding depth, concentration, complexity, and engaging personality.
